

New Volunteer Process FAQ

The FWPL welcomes new members and volunteers. We encourage new volunteers to join one of the many FWPL committees working to support the library. In addition, the semi-annual book sale offers a variety of opportunities to volunteer. Friends sometimes assist at library and community events. A small number of Friends sort donations and manage the Lobby Book Store.

- 1. You do not need to join the FWPL to volunteer. You do not need to volunteer if you join the FWPL. Volunteer and membership applications are separate forms.
- 2. There are three ways to indicate your interest in volunteering
 - a. Fill out a paper form and leave the form at the library (paper forms may be placed on the Friends desk in a green vertical file labeled "Volunteer Forms" located near the window.
 - b. Send an email to the fwplvolunteers@gmail.com
 - c. Fill out a membership form

- 4. Committee Chairpersons will contact volunteers to welcome them and share volunteer opportunities within the committee. They will remind them of the upcoming General Membership Meeting. Some committees may not currently need volunteers. Interested volunteers will be notified that their names will be placed on a waiting list.
